Sustainable places to eat



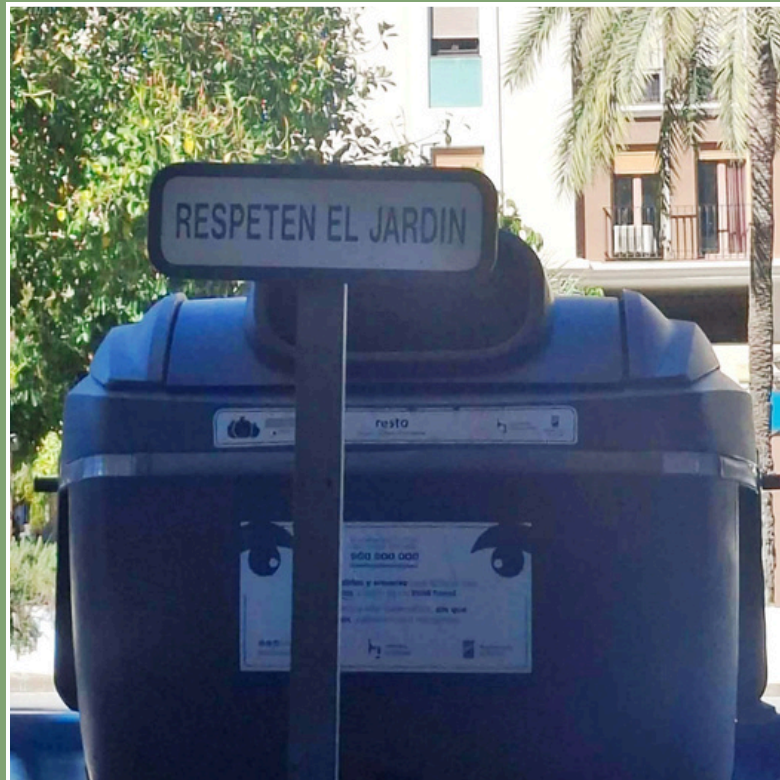
These restaurants serve local and seasonal food. They support nearby farmers and reduce transport.
